Search Examples

1: **Publication Search**

Find the publication **Far Eastern Economic Review; Hong Kong**

TIP: no need to use quotation marks or type the whole title out (use keywords)

2: **Publication Search**

Find all journals with **economy, economic(s), economical** etc in the title

3: **Advanced Search** (Practice finding a specific article)

Find the article “**Companies wise up to real CRM**” from the publication **Asia Computer Weekly**

4: **Advanced Search** (Practice use of Image Caption field, proximity operator, refining)

Find articles with tables, graphs or images that give information on **mobile phones** and **market**. Refine the search to make sure that both keywords are no more than 3 words apart in the Image Caption

5: **Advanced Search** (Practice searching by Subject within one publication and date range)

Find articles from the **last three months** on **International Relations**, published in the journal **The Economist**

6: **Advanced Search** (Practice using Person and Article Type fields)

Find an article containing an **interview** with **Hwang Jang Yop**

NB: if you search and find that the person you are looking for is not indexed in the **Person** field, search for him/her in the Citation & Abstract

7: **Advanced Search** (Practice using Company and Subject fields)

Combine **United Nations** in Company field with **Peacekeeping forces** in subject, in order to find articles that discuss how the UN's role in peacekeeping is working across the globe

8: **Marked List** (Practice emailing articles from the Marked List page)

Email all of your marked articles to yourself

TIP: Click on Marked List to access your marked articles

Suggested Answers

1: **Publication Search**

Find the publication **Far Eastern Economic Review; Hong Kong**

Type **Far Eastern** in the Publication search field. It is not necessary to type in the entire journal title, main keywords from the title will be enough

Click Search and then click on the above journal's link

How many issues are available for this journal?

Click on the latest issue and browse the articles

How far does abstract/indexing go back (Publication Information tab)?

2: **Publication Search**

Find all journals with **economy, economic(s), economical** etc in the title

Type **econom*** in the Publication search field

3: **Advanced Search** (Practice finding a specific article)

Find the article “**Companies wise up to real CRM**” from the publication **Asia Computer Weekly**

Search using the Article Title field. Type in a key phrase from the title. It is not necessary to type the entire title

Select Publication Title field and browse for Management Learning

Once you have found the article, add it to your Marked List

4: **Advanced Search** (Practice use of Image Caption field, proximity operator, refining)
Find articles with tables, graphs or images that give information on **mobile phones** and **market**
Select the Image Caption field to search for both keywords
Refine using the proximity operator from the drop down menu – WITHIN/3 – so that both keywords are found close together in the Image Caption
View and mark an article of your choice

5: **Advanced Search** (Practice searching by Subject within a specific publication)
Find recent articles on **International Relations**, published in the journal **The Economist**
Browse the Thesaurus to check the term **International Relations** has been indexed and then add to your search box
Browse Publication Title to check that **The Economist** is indexed and then add to your search box
Limit your search by date to **the last 3 months**
What is the most recent article? Mark an article of your choice

6: **Advanced Search** (practice searching for different article types and articles that talk about a specific person)
Find articles containing an **interview** with North Korean defector **Hwang Jang Yop**
Choose Article Type from the drop down menu and add **interview**
Choose Person from the drop down menu and browse for **Yop**. This search field will find articles that talk about a person, as opposed to Author
NB: if the person you are looking for is not indexed in the **Person** field, search for him/her in the Citation & Abstract

7: **Advanced Search** (Practice using Company and Subject fields)
Combine **United Nations** in Company field with **Peacekeeping forces** in subject, in order to find articles that discuss how the UN's role in peacekeeping is working across the globe
Choose Company from the drop down menu and add **United Nations**
Browse in the Thesaurus, then add, **Peacekeeping forces**

8: **Marked List** (Practice emailing articles from the Marked List page)
Click on **Marked List** to access your marked articles from this current session only
Email all of your marked articles to yourself
