ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source provides abstracting and indexing for more than 780 titles, with over 650 titles in full-text, plus more than 11,000 full text dissertations representing the most rigorous scholarship in nursing and related fields.

The breadth of healthcare information covered includes 70 wide-ranging topics including:

ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source content goes as far back as 1986 and provides unique content and tools:

The **Joanna Briggs Institute** Evidence-based Nursing content -- This highly sought after information allows practicing nurses and nursing students to see clearly and simply where nursing decisions are supported by evidence. Users have access to:

- **Systematic Reviews** – extensive summaries of all research on selected clinical topics.
- **Evidence Summaries** - short extracts of research literature on selected clinical topics that are based on structured searches of the literature and selected evidence-based health care databases. They focus on the characteristics of the evidence, the clinical bottom line, and best practice recommendations.
- **Best Practice Information Sheets (BPIS)** - summaries derived from the findings of systematic reviews of evidence.

In addition, access to **JBI Connect** gives nurses RAPid and SUMARI, tools that teach appraisal and critiquing skills as well as the software to submit and publish these reviews.

Study Paths – Prepared by a board of experienced nurse educators, study paths provide a curriculum-based topic tree that connects users to appropriate articles on specific topics. Meant to reflect the standard nursing curriculum both for LPNs and RNs, this tool helps students complete their assignments, research a topic, and prepare for examinations.

CultureVision – These are extensive reports written by researchers that include insights and guidance to raise awareness of cultural beliefs and practices in relation to healthcare. These reports facilitate understanding to avoid cultural misunderstandings and improve outcomes. Updated monthly and provide information for 30 ethnicities and 11 religions.
