For example, as a young officer serving in India in 1897, Winston Churchill asked his mother to send him the last 27 volumes of *The Annual Register*, so that he could study the accounts of British politics as preparation for standing as an MP. Within two years he was appearing in its pages himself, and when he died in 1965 the *Register* devoted a special preface to him.
